The A38 westbound will be closed from Marley Head to Woodpecker junction (South Brent). Convoy working will be in place from Woodpecker junction (South Brent) to Wrangaton.

Diversion

A38 westbound traffic will leave the A38 at Marley Head, follow the B3372 and rejoin the A38 at Woodpecker junction (South Brent).
