A38 Marley Head to Wrangaton westbound Overnight resurfacing - 8pm to 6am 25 September to 13 October 2023

National Highways operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A-roads.

Further to our surveys in July, this postcard is to let you know we'll be carrying out overnight resurfacing work on the A38 westbound carriageway between Marley Head and Wrangaton, including South Brent entry slip and Wrangaton exit slip (westbound). We'll work Monday to Friday overnight when traffic flows are at their lowest. During the day the road will be open as usual.

Please accept our apologies in advance for any inconvenience which may be caused. We'll make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to a minimum.

Traffic management

The A38 westbound will be closed from Marley Head to South Brent junction. Convoy working will be in place from South Brent junction to Wrangaton.

Diversions

- **25 September and 2 October to 13 October (6am)** - A38 westbound traffic will leave the A38 at Marley Head, follow the B3372 and rejoin the A38 at South Brent junction.
- **26, 27, 28 and 29 September** - Local traffic wishing to join the A38 via South Brent westbound entry slip will be diverted to the B3372 to rejoin the A38 at Marley Head.
- **28, 29 September 2 and 3 October** - traffic wishing to leave via the A38 westbound Wrangaton exit slip will be diverted to Ivybridge (Westover) to follow B3213 through Bittaford. Temporary traffic signals will be on the local highway authority network adjacent to the top of Wrangaton slip road for these 4 overnight shifts.

We always aim to work to the programme, however unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions may mean changes. We have provisionally booked an overnight shift for the 13 October 2023 to cover unplanned events.
