TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC & PARKING

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL hereby give **NOTICE** that:

From **MONDAY 9 SEPTEMBER 2024**
for a maximum of 5 days

Until **FRIDAY 13 SEPTEMBER 2024** (both dates inclusive)

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait on the sections of Affected Roads.

AISH BRIDGE TO LITTLE BRENT MILL, SOUTH BRENT

DIVERSION 1 - AISH BRIDGE TO LITTLE BRENT MILL, ROAD FROM LITTLE AISH TO AISH BRIDGE CROSS, AISH LANE TO VICARAGE ROAD, WELLINGTON SQUARE TO WELL OAK, STATION APPROACH, STATION ROAD, PLYMOUTH ROAD, B3372, EXETER ROAD TO AISH LANE END, AISH BRIDGE TO LITTLE BRENT MILL
DIVERSION 2 - AISH BRIDGE TO LITTLE BRENT MILL, EXETER ROAD TO AISH LANE END, B3372, PLYMOUTH ROAD, CHURCH STREET, WELLINGTON SQUARE, WELLINGTON SQUARE TO WELL OAK, AISH LANE TO VICARAGE ROAD, ROAD FROM LITTLE AISH TO AISH BRIDGE CROSS, AISH BRIDGE TO LITTLE BRENT MILL
