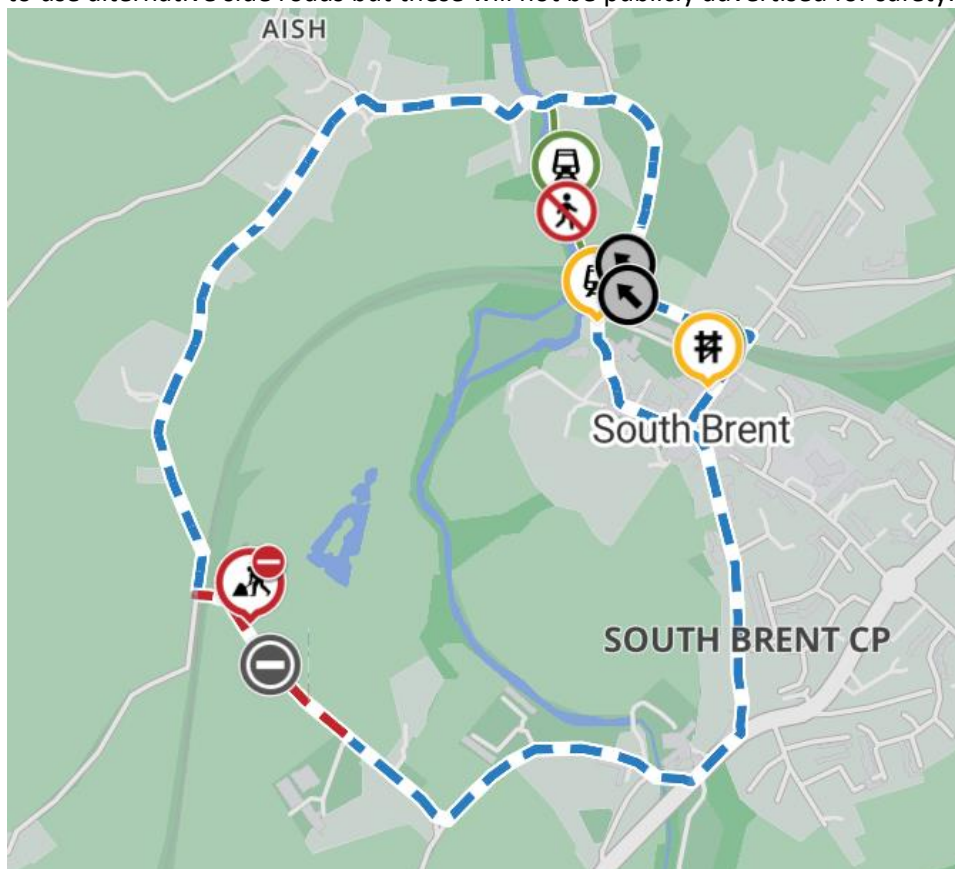
This letter is to give you some further information about the forthcoming drainage scheme between Aish Bridge and Little Brent Mill.

Due to the nature of the works a road closure is required and the diversionary route for traffic will be signposted and advance signs will also be placed on the Highway. Emergency access will be maintained, as well as access for residents within the closure.

The planned on-site working hours will be.

- Monday 9th September to Friday 13th September

Please see the road closure and works area highlighted in **red** on the map below, there will be a signed diversion route which is shown on the map in **blue**. Drivers with local knowledge will be able to use alternative side roads but these will not be publicly advertised for safety.
